



Honors Contract for an Honors Eligible Course

Contract Overview

An honors contract is a binding agreement between a student and faculty member that enrolls a student in an honors version of a standard course. Students should expect to produce additional or alternative work, to produce high quality work, and to meet regularly throughout the semester with their faculty instructor. The honors contract enrolls a student in an honors course and therefore cannot be cancelled after the final deadline to modify a course (this date varies by semester. Please see the Honors Canvas Page for the current dates). Failure to complete the contract will be reflected in the course grade.

Contracts are due to the Honors Advisor Council early in the semester. The actual date changes based on the term length (dates for the current semester can be found on the Honors Canvas Page), but a good rule of thumb is by the end of the second week of classes for 15-week courses and the end of the first week for any other term length. Contracts must be completed and signed by all parties and will only be accepted electronically at honors@aacc.edu.
