Student Achievement and Success Program (SASP) Scholarship Eligibility and Selection Procedures November 2016

- o Black Male Initiative (BMI) requirement of 15 hours of academic support/supplemental instruction (includes ACA 100 or BMI retreat, SASP/FYE/DEV Lab, Pathway workshops).
- Students ineligible to receive the SASP Scholarship:
 - Students who are dependents or the spouse of regular college faculty or staff who are receiving (or eligible to receive) a tuition waiver.
 - Students who have not filed taxes for the year utilized to determine eligibility for Title IV financial aid.
 - Students who are not current with selective service.
 - o Students who have Department of Homeland Security (DHLS) holds.
 - o Students who have outstanding SASP loaned textbooks, calculators or laptops.
 - o Students with an earned 1st associate's degree or bachelor's degree.
 - o Students who have exceeded the maximum award amount (\$2000).
 - o Participants not meeting any of the eligibility requirements may be considered in subsequent enrolled term(s) if eligibility criteria are attained.
